Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 18th June last. I would of course be pleased to act for you and your people, but before communicating with the Government, I should have to look up the authorities and all acts dealing with the Indians. This would entail some considerable expense as I should probably have to write to Ottawa as well as Victoria and before taking any steps, I shall be glad if you will kindly let me have \$50 as costs of preparing the case.

With regard to interviewing the Government, my fee for laying your case before the Provincial Government in Victoria will be \$100 and expenses. but if it is necessary to go to Ottawa, I should of course require a much larger fee. In the meantime, if you will kindly let me have the \$50, I will get up the ~~appeal~~ case.
