

THIS INDENTURE

made this 9th. day of September 1916 .

BETWEEN Stephen Morgan party of the first part, and
Balmoral Cannery ----- party of the second part.

WITNESSETH. In consideration of the party of the second part lending
the party of the first part the sum of One hundred Dollars. \$100.00,
the party of the first part agrees to deliver to the party of the
second part, all the salmon he catches, at the regular prices, until
such time he is able to repay the One hundred Dollars \$100.00 above
mentioned. The party of the second part agrees not to take all the
money for the fish delivered, but to give to the party of the first
part, what he shall require for living expenses.

The party of the first part agrees to consider that the
party of the second part has a One Hundred Dollar share in his
Gasoline Boat, until such time as the above mentioned one hundred
Dollars loaned to him shall be returned in full.
