

Location Dependence


Bike rental docking stations are concentrated in the downtown core





Packaging and our solution - A mounting rack.











Manufacturing, Cost Per Unit







Incorporation of an accelerometer into the delegator to monitor for motion and the use of financial penalties as incentive for users to properly lock the device.

Waterproofing, heat proofing, and adequate structural designs to mitigate severity of damages.

Swivel will have a repair and recycle program, if a device cannot be fixed Swivel will get the recyclable components and attempt to use the non-recyclable ones

Time Management - Allow more time to build redundant systems

Spend more time prototyping without sacrificing necessary forethought

Run more tasks in parallel when possible, and leave enough time for integration. Do not assume two working pieces will work together.

Future Plans

As of current day there are no concrete plans to continue to develop the Swivel product line after ENSC 440

While the idea has many merits, the barrier to entry and company risk is high enough that we have reservations about continuing the business

The work done on the Swivel platform will be documented for the possibility of continuation in the future
