the united Indians of British Columbia
ask any thing by the Dominion of cana-
da they will get it sure said the Law-
yer to me, if the Indians are not united
they will never get any thing done he
said to me, if the Indians not take
my advise they will never win the
argument said the Lawyer, so I want
you to call all the people and have a good
conversation about this I want you to
go up Hazelton and ask Charles Mowatt

what the Lawyer said. and he will
 give you a full particular. now Mr -
 Morgan you are the only man that
 I know could stand have this good
 idea done. I will sent you another
 letter again after a while. if you people
 wanted me to go up and see you people
 about this. of-course all the Indians on van-
 couver Island is ready to be united they are
 waiting for your people. you remember
 Chief Mathias Capilano goe son. this man is
 out of business the Indians on van-cou-
 ver Island put him out. because they found
 out his is nothier. so all the Indians
 around van-cou-
 ver and on van-cou-
 ver Island is united on account ~~con~~ of
 conscription. the conscription will come
 out some time this year or may be
 next year. it will be some trouble ab-
 out this the united Indians will be
 strong for any thing happens said
 the Lawyer not only for the conscrip-
 tion if we talk about our land. the
 united Indians will be strong just the
 same. all of this regard is good for you
