The Burnaby Museum is a combination of heritage and replica buildings on a 10-acre site. Period costumed townsfolk welcome visitors and give demonstrations in the homes, businesses and shops. Be sure to take in the elegance of the Interurban #1223 and the interactive tram exhibit. An exciting must for every visitor is a

whirl on the historic 1912 CW Parker Carousel. Amenities include an ice-cream parlour which offers a menu for light meals and snacks, picnic tables, and a gift shop. The site is wheelchair accessible. Experience heritage in a traditional BC Electric Railway tram stop community.
