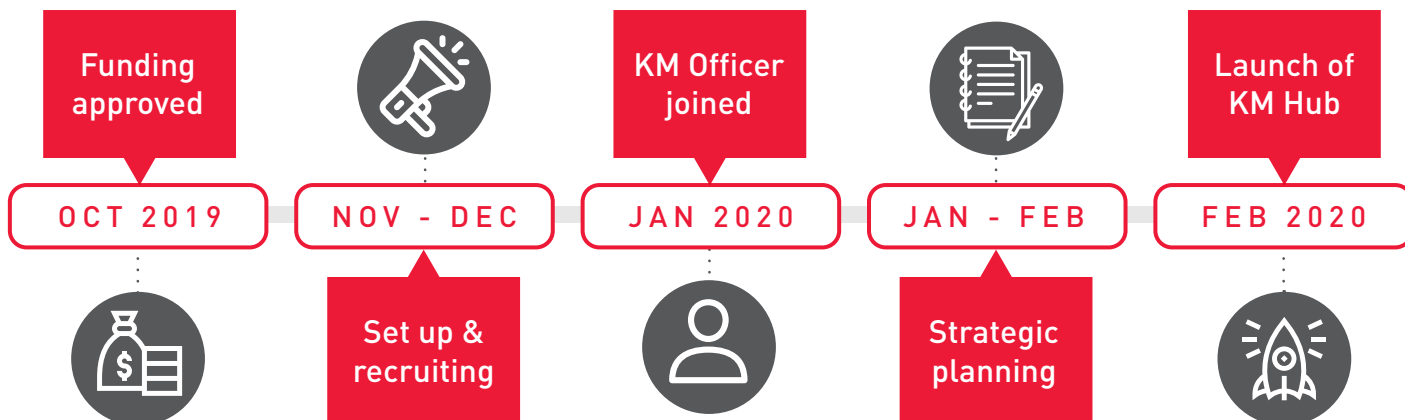

- Recognition - highlighting SFU mobilizers

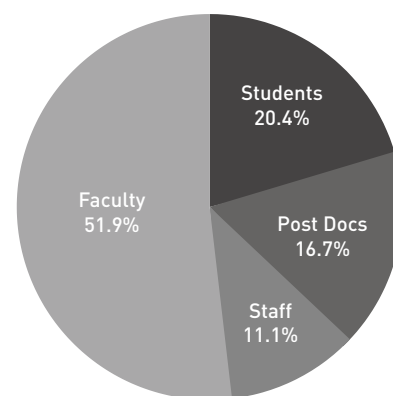
### CONSULTATIONS

Since the launch in February we have supported 52 researchers from across all 8 faculties. This included: developing KM plans, providing letters of support, and assisting with KM outputs.
